Dear Parents,

Welcome to our school community! It is time to start enrollment for next school year. Enclosed, you will find all the information you need for this process.

Please note these very important dates:

January 29 – February 10: Enrollment for current students at St. Peter and St. Elizabeth St. Robert Regional School and their siblings. **To guarantee you child's spot, you must turn in your forms and deposit during this enrollment period.**

February 13 – February 24: Enrollment for new students whose families are registered at either St. Peter, St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, or St. Robert parish.

February 27: Enrollment opens to all.

We assure current families of SESR and St. Peter School that every child who enrolls before February 10 is secure of a spot in the school. We are prepared to open a second homeroom for class sizes that exceed our limit of 32 students, according to the School Board Policy. For classes that remain below 32 students, we will start a waiting list until we have enough students to add a second homeroom.

Additional teacher aides and/or certified teachers will be hired to assist teachers of larger homerooms, ensuring that we will be able to provide an engaging and supportive educational experience with lots of teacher-contact time for our students.

Decisions regarding whether or not to add homerooms, hire additional faculty, purchase more furnishings, textbooks, and computers must be made by the end of March. Therefore, I urge you to return your forms and deposit as soon as possible.

Included in your envelope is a packet of information from the Archdiocese of St. Louis concerning financial aid through the *Today and Tomorrow Education Foundation*. New funds have been allocated for all students in Catholic elementary and high schools. You will notice that there is now tuition assistance for families in the "Middle Income" range. Apply NOW! These funds are distributed on a first-come, first-served basis. If you have any questions, there is a phone number included in the packet, as well as several information nights in early February.

If you would like to be considered for financial aid through your home parish, please contact your parish rectory office.

As always, do not hesitate to call the office if you have questions regarding enrollment.
